The **provisional** figures (17-09-2018) for **influx academic year 2018-2019** at Bachelor's and Master's level show that:

Total

- The overall <u>composition</u> of this year's influx (BSc/MSc) is: 2/3 Dutch, 1/3 international.
- At Bachelor's level, both national and international influx is growing; at Master's level, national influx has slightly decreased.
- The provisional total number of Bachelor's students has grown from 1874 to 2193. This is an increase of 17% (319 students) compared to 2017-2018.
- At Master's level, we see a slight increase of 2% in the total number of students.

International

- Overall, the University has received more international students than last year. This year's **international** influx at bachelor's level has increased by 39% compared to 2017-2018. At master's level, the increase is less: 18%.
- In absolute terms, the provisional number of incoming **international** students at Bachelor's level is 773 (versus 555 last year). At master's level, the number has risen from 346 to 407.
- Dutch influx at Bachelor's level grew with approximately 100 students; at Master's level Dutch influx dropped with 40 students (from 720 to 680).

EER (without Germany)/non-EER

- Overall, the <u>composition</u> of this year's incoming population has changed slightly compared to that of last year's. Relatively speaking, the share of Dutch and German influx is smaller, while that of EER (excluding German nationals) and non-EER has grown considerably.
- When looking more closely at the number of incoming EER-students (excluding German nationals) and non-EER, we can see an increase of 58% (EER) and 162% at Bachelor's level compared to last year.



The current figures (31-08-2018) on **UT staff composition** show that:

Total

- The current overall composition of UT staff in terms of nationality is: 3/4 Dutch, 1/4 international.
- More than half of our PhD-students are of non-Dutch descent (45%).
- In scientific staff (excluding PhD-students), the share of non-Dutch staff members is 1/3.
- About 4% of support staff members is of non-Dutch origin.
