Dear Executive Board.

Recently, a number of articles have been published related to the housing situation (see below). I.a. issues have been raised around:

- high room pricings of Camelot;
- legally questionable contracts of Camelot with regard to tenancy (huurrecht) (double costs, too high deposits, high registration costs, required purchases), and
- especially internationals being unable to find accommodation and falling back on "couchsurfing", which in the end leads to them leaving back to their home country.

We are aware of the efforts from Gemeente<sup>1</sup> and De Veste<sup>2</sup> regarding international accommodation and understand that housing is not a direct responsibility of the University. Nevertheless, we are associated with it.

In de Overleglegvergadering of August, the CvB acknowledges the supply/demand issues regarding Camelot and has stated that more attention will be given to professionalise the housing situation.

## Questions:

- 1. In the article "Kamerverhuur onder Vuur", Tubantia, the university states that the prices of Camelot are high, and that the university gave advice but doesn't have any influence on the final pricings. Nevertheless, the website of the university still promotes Camelot. To what extent do we want to be associated to Camelot based on their image?
- 2. Hogekamp will be available for Dutch students from January on. Tubantia states that the renting prices will maybe be adjusted. Are there any conversations about these actions?
- 3. What is the current situation and conversation with Camelot? Are there any?
